

The Key to Overcoming Victory

Col 1:9-13 For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; 10 That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; 11 Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness; 12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: 13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son:

A. Understanding the Prayer.

1. The key elements: God's will, walking worthy, strengthened with all might.
2. Filled with the knowledge of His will.
 - a. Demand on your behalf.
 - b. Filled with.
 - c. The knowledge.
 - d. Of His will.
 - e. In all wisdom and spiritual understanding.
3. That you may walk worthy of the Lord.
 - a. Conforming your life and lifestyle.
 - b. Unto all pleasing (of God).
 - c. Being fruitful in every good work.
 - d. Increasing in the knowledge of God.
4. Strengthened with all might.
 - a. According to his glorious power.
 - b. Unto all patience and longsuffering.
 - c. With joyfulness, giving thanks unto the Father.
 - d. Made meet (thoroughly furnished) to be partakers of the inheritance.
 - e. Delivered from the power of darkness into the kingdom of Jesus the Christ.

B. Applying the Prayer.

1. Partnering with God. The place of victory.
 - a. That you might be... Subjunctive mood – potential.
 - b. In all wisdom and spiritual understanding.
 - c. Walking worthy (conforming your life).
2. Filled with God's will. What is his will for you? Search the Word and pray. God's will for us covers 2 aspects; what we are to be and what we are to do.
 - a. Fear God, keep his commandments, this is the duty of man. Ecc 12:13
 - b. Do justly, love mercy, walk humbly with your God. Mic 6:8
 - c. Love God with all your heart, soul, mind, and strength. Mar 12:30

- d. Love your neighbor as yourself. Mar 12:31
- e. Be transformed by the Word to know the will of God. Rom 12:2
- f. We are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works. Eph 2:10
- g. This is the will of God, even your sanctification. 1 Th 4:3
- h. Seek first the Kingdom of God and his righteousness. Mat 6:33

C. Cooperating with God to Do His Will.

1. Strengthened with all might according to his glorious power. Col 1:11a
 - a. Rely on the HS in you by praying in tongues a lot.
 - b. Speak the Word of God over your life in proclamations and affirmations.
 - c. Speak USP's often to stay under grace.
 - d. Regularly re-establish the KOG in your life and surroundings.
 - e. Take authority over the demonic forces because you have been delivered from the power of darkness and translated into the kingdom of Jesus.
2. Unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness. Col 1:11b
 - a. Patience and longsuffering are not waiting on God but doing the will of God.
 - b. Temperance (self-control) along with persistence pushes through the obstacles.
 - c. Interval Living (IL) and the Covenant Matrix (CM) keeps you on track to walk worthy regarding the will of God for you.
 - d. The successful accomplishment of completing the Will of God each day through IL and CM brings the joy of the Lord.
3. He has made us meet (thoroughly furnished) to be partakers of the inheritance.
 - a. Remember the goal – to become the glorious church to be alive and remaining at the rapture.
